

**LAKE GENEVA POLICE AND FIRE COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES
THURSDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2016 AT 7:00 P.M.**

This meeting was held in the City Council Chambers, City Hall, 626 Geneva Street, Lake Geneva, Wisconsin, 53147.

1. Call meeting to order

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Hartz at 7:02 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Bittner

3. Roll call

Commissioners Bittner, Jordan and Hartz were present. Commissioners Gramm and Pollard were excused. Police and Fire Liaison Howell and Town of Geneva Fire Liaison Walton were present.

4. Comments from the Public reference agenda items only. Comments are limited to a maximum of five minutes - NONE

6. Police and Fire Commission Workshop November 4, 2016

There will be a Police and Fire Commission Workshop November 4, 2016 and Commissioner Jordan will attend.

7. Police and Fire Commission Packet Distribution Process follow-up

Packet distribution was discussed. The same process will be continued for one more month.

8. Approval of regular meeting minutes September 8, 2016

Bittner motioned to approve the minutes from September 8, 2016. Hartz seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

9. Fire Department Business:

a. Approval of bills for the month of September 2016 operating in the amount of \$72,368.37, Capital in the amount of \$464.88, for a total of \$72,833.25

Jordan motioned to approve the bills for the month of September 2016. Bittner seconded. Roll call vote: Jordan -Y, Bittner-Y, Hartz-Y. Motion carried 3-0.

Interim Chief Peters went over some budget items that were over budget, however, the overall budget is still within budget guidelines.

b. Monthly EMS Medical Billing/Stark Report/Charge Detail Report

There will be a meeting next week with EMS to revise the reports and make them easier to read.

c. Monthly Fire Department Report

Interim Chief Peters reviewed the monthly report. He highlighted Firefighter Pat Carroll's 37 years of service.

e. Donations from Robert N. Rios and Christine Rios

Jordan motioned to accept \$20.00 donation from Robert N. and Christine Rios. Hartz seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

The Fire Department received \$20.00 from the Rios family for care that Robert Rios received.

f. Apparatus inspection and repair report

Emergency Apparatus Maintenance inspected the ambulances and found several repairs were needed on the ambulances. In the past, ambulances were only sent in for oil changes. The ambulances will be inspected at the time of oil changes in the future to avoid large expenses all at once.

g. Donation expenditure-RTF

Hartz motioned to approve spending \$9798.00 for Rescue Task Force Medical bags from the donation account. Jordan seconded. Roll call vote: Jordan – Y, Bittner – Y, Hartz – Y. Motion carried 3-0. Interim Chief Peters asked the Commission to approve spending \$9798.00 to purchase special bags containing special items prepared for active shooting disasters. The bags will allow EMTs to provide medical care in a quicker fashion during a disaster.

The Fire Department Awards Ceremony is scheduled for October 13, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

Jordan motioned to dispose of old equipment. Bittner seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Assistant Chief Heindl made a list of items that the fire department would like to dispose of. The items are all broken and are only good for scrap. There is also an old ambulance in impound the department would like to decommission. The items will be liquidated and the money brought back to the general fund.

10. Police Department Business

a. Approval of bills for the month of September 2016, operating in the amount of \$215,651.62, Capital in the amount of \$219.87, for a total of \$215,871.49.

Bittner motioned to approve the bills for the month of September 2016. Jordan seconded. Roll call vote: Jordan – Y, Bittner –Y, Hartz – Y. Motioned carried 3-0.

Chief Rasmussen noted that overtime is still up, however, restitution was received to reimburse for some of that amount. Department staffing is ok at this time. The overall budget is at 72.6%

b. On duty officer injury update

The injured officer had foot surgery and will be out for three to six months. Hopefully the officer will be able to return to full duty.

c. Letter of resignation from Part Time Officer Sergio Martini
Bittner motioned to approve letter of resignation for Part Time Officer Sergio Martini. Bittner seconded.
Motion carried 3-0.

d. Lions Club Drone Donation Request

Chief Rasmussen and Interim Fire Chief Peters made a drone presentation at a recent Lions Club Meeting. The Lions Club is looking at making a donation to purchase a drone for the police and fire departments. Bittner is a member of the Lions club and stated that the drone purchase will be on the Lions Club agenda next month for full approval. Bittner noted that he felt the drone would be helpful when searching for missing people on the lake or ice. Chief Rasmussen said the drone would be made available to surrounding areas if needed. A license is required to operate a drone and two police officers and two firefighters will be licensed.

e. Chief and Command Staff Appraisals – Status

Hartz stated that he would like to schedule an hour workshop to work on the evaluations based upon the feedback he received from the commission members last month. A workshop date will be set up at the next meeting.

Hartz stated that changing a job requirement for one person was not a policy the Commission would like to start.

Jordan motioned to appoint interim Chief Peters to be the permanent Fire Department Chief. Bittner seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Jordan stated that he felt Chief Peters has been doing a wonderful job and is making great changes for the department. Hartz also noted that Chief Peters is developing trust within the department and within the community and appreciates his efforts.

Bittner motioned to adjourn the meeting. Jordan seconded. Motion carried 3-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:42 p.m.
