Park Board Report: Al Kupsik reported the Gygax memorial has been approved and will be placed on a 10x 10 ft space and will be selling bricks to fund the 25 year maintenance agreement. Disk golf will soon be finished with some cleanup to be done. The dog park is waiting for funding. Concession stand to be opened soon.

President Kirchberg reported on behalf of John Foster the concern of trees on the corner of Maxwell and Geneva. Motion by Bob Flemming, seconded by Al Kupsik to approve the removal. Motion carried. Motion by Bob Flemming, seconded by George Troupis that future tree concerns (if approved by John Foster) the tree board would give the approval to remove. Motion carried.

Arbor Day is scheduled for Saturday, April 26 at 9:00 a.m. A burr oak will be planted at the Skate Board Park and dedicated to them.
