Arborist Report: Jon Foster reported that the only trees to be planted this spring are the Flowering Pears to be planted along hwy 50. We only have \$5,000 to spend for new tree planting. The street dept is almost monitoring trees on Geneva St., Maxwell St. and Warren St. A large sugar maple on Geneva St will be removed and the core saved for use in Maple Park.

Arbor Day Report: Arbor Day has been set for Saturday, April 29, at 9:00 a.m. in Library Park. A motion was made by Joe Esposito, seconded by Bob Flemming to plant an Autumn Blaze Maple to honor Dan Winkler. Motion carried.

Tree City USA Flags: We are asking to be able to fly the tree city flags at Driehaus Plaza, City Hall and the Water Dept. These would fly from April 21 to May.

Tree identifying: Candy is still working on ordering the plaques. Joe, Steve and Clara will assist when she gets more information. She would like to start with about 50 trees, starting in Library Park.
