Cindi, on behalf of the citizens of Lake Geneva and the members of the department, we thank you for the past year of service and look forward to many more.


Personnel Introductions

Community & Department Events

- During the weekend of Winterfest department personnel provided EMS standby services at the Riviera. This event marked the first deployment of the newly finished Utility 2. On the first night, it responded to its inaugural incident downtown and immediately demonstrated the purpose of the vehicle; rapid deployment and capable of navigating pedestrian and vehicle traffic downtown.



- February 6th, we received a visit from Firefighter/Paramedic Hartlaub's sister, Anna. It was a special day for her; it was her 25th birthday. On such a special day, she tasked herself with performing 25 random acts of kindness. Accompanied by her family, she bestowed donuts upon us for the firehouse and police department.

- February 20th was National Pet Day. In celebration of “his” day, Hank (the rightful owner of Firefighter/Paramedic Carly Behrens) visited us and tried to exert his dominance by commandeering Engine 1. However, he was unable to reach the pedals thus had to settle for a ride.



Notable Calls for Service

- On the afternoon of February 6th, EMS was dispatched to Main St and Center St for a fall victim. Upon arrival, the patient was found to have a significant head injury and major bleeding. The patient was stabilized and transported to Froedtert for emergency, trauma care Crew- FF/EMT Steltenpohl, FF/PM Pillman, and PM Neumueller.
- On February 7th the Elkhorn Fire Department requested a paramedic unit for a cardiac arrest. The patient was resuscitated in the field and transported to a local hospital for stabilization and subsequently transferred.

- At 1:32pm on February 24th the department was dispatched auto-aid for Lyons Fire Department for the report of a structure fire in Hillmoor Heights. First arriving personnel began fire suppression and search operations. One occupant was found deceased within the residence.
