General Description(s):

The Lake Geneva Utility Commission is seeking to recruit energetic, independent, well organized, community-oriented individuals to fill two vacancies within our team of Wastewater professionals.

These positions will be focused on process control and mechanical maintenance within the collection and treatment system, along with maintenance, repair, and construction activities within the Utility's collection system.

These positions are subject to after-hours, weekend, and holiday work on a rotational basis, along with a 30-minute response time when on call.

Qualifications:

Valid Wisconsin Regular Driver's License is required, and Commercial Driver's License (CDL) is preferred but must be obtained within 12 months of hire.

Requires a high school diploma or equivalent and experience in utility operations or construction, and/or experience with plumbing, mechanical, electrical, or facilities maintenance.

Ideal Candidates will have supplementary education courses in utility operations, environmental science, public health or a closely related field, and/or at least five (5) years of progressive municipal wastewater utility work; and possess Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Wastewater Operator's Certificate; A1 – Suspended Growth, B – Solids Separation, C – Biological Solids, L – Laboratory, N – Nitrogen, and SS – Collection System.

Selection Process:

Interested candidates must submit a letter of interest and detailed resume to the attention of the Utility Director as addressed below. Preliminary interviews and reference check will be performed with selected applicants, with secondary interviews being performed for final candidate selection.

Selected candidate may be subject to job related testing and will be subject to a background check and pre-employment drug screen and physical.
